

PETITION INSTRUCTIONS

Petitions are vital for the candidate to get on the ballot, and although not complicated there are rules that must be followed. **CIRCULATORS MUST BE 18 YEARS OLD AND A US CITIZEN.**

PETITION SIGNING PERIOD JANUARY 13 – MARCH 14, 2022.

The following items need to be observed while circulating the petition:

1. The headings of the petition must be completed prior to circulation of the sheet. The campaign will complete this information and provide you with a petition ready for voters' signatures.
2. The blank petitions may be photocopied, again once received from the Noverini Campaign. However, all signatures of the voters and the signature of the circulator, must be originals.
3. Do **not** sign as the circulator until the entire petition is filled with voters' signatures and you are with a Notary having it notarized. If you don't have a Notary to notarize call Saray at 847 877-0619.
4. If a voter prints their name, instead of signing, you must have them re-do this on another line. cross out the entire original line, since a printed name instead of a signature is **invalid**.
5. Ask the voter to **sign** their name and **print** their entire address. Do not use quote marks " " to replicate information from the line above.
6. You must witness the signatures **in person**, you cannot leave the sheet somewhere, say at a table at an event, and come back to pick it up when completed. When you have your circulator signature notarized that is confirmation that you witnessed each person sign.
7. Signers must be a registered voter in one of the five counties in Illinois that Judge Noverini is seeking nomination. The counties for this office are Lake, Kane Kendall, DeKalb and McHenry.
8. A signer must sign their own signature on the petition, meaning they cannot sign for someone else, such as their spouse, another member of the family or another person in the household.
9. You can only circulate for one political party.
10. Petition signers shall indicate on the petition their residence address including the street address or rural number, as well as their city, village or town, county and state. The State, county, city/village and town of residence may be pre-printed on the petition form when all of the voters' signing the petition form reside at these locations. For instance, if you are going to neighbors, you can pre-write your city and state on all the lines so the voter only needs to sign their name and print their street number and street name.
11. Finally – **DO NOT fill in Sheet No. _____** at the bottom of the Petition – leave it blank.
12. When finished, call Saray at 847-877-0619 to know the nearest place you can submit your petitions.
13. Tip: Start a list now of every registered voter you know in ... DeKalb, Kane, Kendall, Lake & McHenry!
